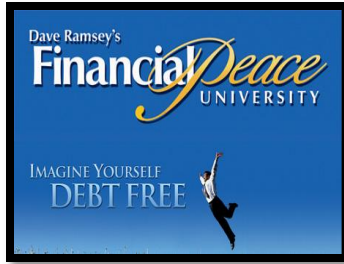

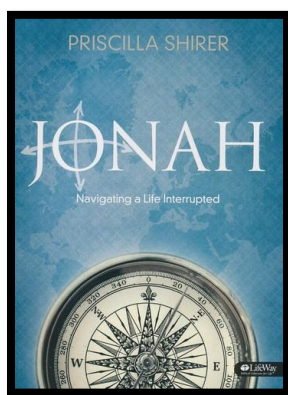

A STUDY OF END TIMES – ESCATOLOGY (10-Weeks)

interpret the prophetic literature then we will examine what the Bible predicts about the future of the Jewish people, Gentile nations, and the church. We will examine select passages from Isaiah, Daniel, Ezekiel, Zechariah, Malachi, Matthew, Thessalonians and the Revelation. We will

answer questions like: What is God's prophetic plan for national Israel? Does the church go through the Tribulation period? What will happen at the Bema Judgment Seat for believers? When will Old Testament saints be resurrected? Can we know the exact day when Christ will return? Will we see Armageddon? How should we live in light of the imminent return of our Savior?

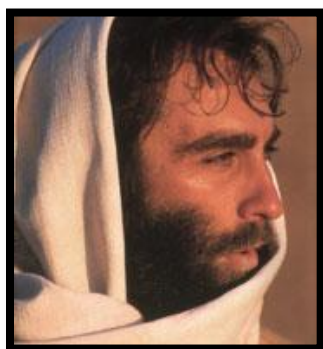

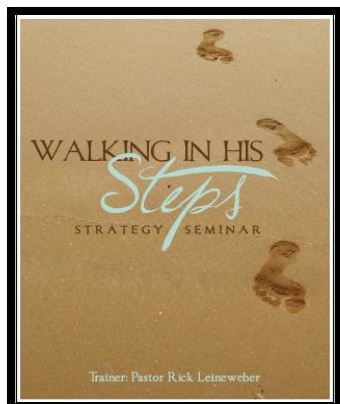
