1. What is the Big Idea of the book of Esther? How does this impact our daily walk with Christ?
2. What is this week's Christ Connection? How do you see Christ portrayed through this book?
3. How can we apply the big picture concepts of Esther to our lives and daily walk of faith?

4. Esther, like Christ, put herself in the place of death for her people and also functioned as an advocate for her people even as Christ functions as an advocate for us. How can we use this example to mature and deepen our faith?
  
5. Even though God's name is not mentioned in the entire book of Esther, his fingerprints are on every page. Do you see God's fingerprints in this story and on every page of your life story? Give examples.
  
6. What insights about the evil of racism can you identify in the book of Esther?
  
7. How were you created for 'such a time as this'? Are there instances you have seen in your life where God had you in a particular place for a reason?
  
8. Without even being named in the book, God's provincial care was evident for his people. What lessons can we bring forward from this into our modern time?
